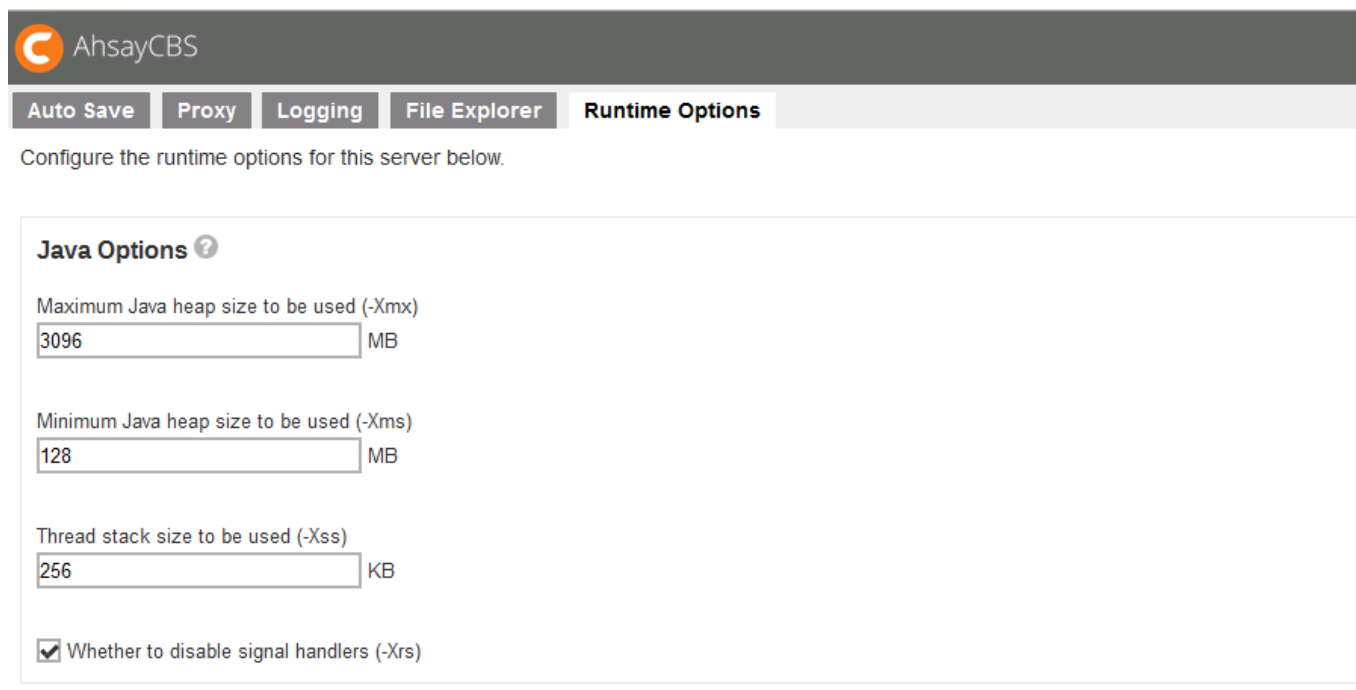
## Description

This article outlines the steps required to modify the Java heap size of AhsayCBS.

## Steps

To modify the Java heap size of AhsayCBS:

1. Login to the Ahsay Cloud Backup Suite web management console.
2. Go to **System Settings > Advanced > Runtime Options**.
3. Enter the new heap size settings in the Heap Size text boxes, then press **Save**.
