
## **Description**

This article contains instruction on how to restrict access to the AhsayCBS web console by IP address.

## **Steps**

Refer to the following steps to create IP allowed range to allow access to the AhsayCBS web console only from specific IP address range(s):

- 1. Login to the AhsayCBS web console.
- 2. Select Advanced under System Settings.



- 3. Select the **Runtime Options** tab.
- 4. Edit the default IP allowed range by clicking on the corresponding IP range, or create a new IP allowed range by clicking **Create** (circular + button), under **IP Allowed** .



**Note**: By default, an IP allowed range from 0.0.0.0 to 255.255.255 is created to allow access to the web console from all IP address.

5. Enter the corresponding IP range under IP Allowed .

For example, enter **From** 192.168.1.1 **To** 192.168.1.255 to allow access to only computer connecting from the 192.168.1.x network to access the web console.



6. Click **OK** , then **Save** afterward to save the changes.

**Note**: If required, you can configure more than one IP allowed ranges.
